

Annual Slavery and Human Trafficking Statement 2017

As a responsible company, the Kiril Mischeff Group is committed to Ethical, Social and Environmental principles.

We are committed to ethical sourcing and trading and work with our suppliers to ensure that decent, safe and legal working conditions are provided for all workers involved in the supply chain of products produced for Kiril Mischeff, including all parts of our own business.

We ask suppliers to complete our internal Ethical Audit Questionnaire. This is based on the E.T.I Base Code and the Modern Slavery Act 2015, and includes reference to Forced and Bonded Labour, Human Trafficking and Exploitation. In addition, we expect suppliers to register with Sedex.

Suppliers are asked to confirm that they have read and understood the objectives of the “Stronger Together” initiative regarding Hidden Labour Exploitation and copies of this policy have been displayed on the notice boards at all parts of our own businesses.

A member of Kiril Mischeff attended a “ Tackling Modern Slavery in the Global Supply Chain ” workshop organised by Stronger Together.
